Easy steps to planning your dream bathroom

A stylish bathroom does not have to be expensive, but to make the best use of the space available, you need to plan the layout carefully.

Follow these simple steps and you will see just how easy it is.

- Firstly, on the grid provided carefully draw to scale the internal dimensions of your bathroom.
- Now, draw in the position of any doors and windows and the way they open. Note beside each window the height between the floor and the sill (helpful when placing baths, toilets and vanities).
- If any existing plumbing (taps, shower mixer, inlet pipes, water pipes and toilet waste pipe) or electrical fittings (heaters, electrical points and switches) are to remain, mark these clearly with a different coloured pen.
- Place your selected push-out shapes on the grid and move them around until you find the best layout. Take care to allow enough space around each item for it to be used with ease. Don't forget door openings!
- Now you can start looking for the ideal products best suited to your plan and budget. Your local Mitre 10 Bathroom Specialist can assist you with your product selection and quotations. They can also offer expert advice on all your plumbing requirements.

Selecting the right product

Showers, vanities, baths and toilets are usually the dominant features of any bathroom. Apart from having to be a practical choice, there are many styles and features available to really enhance the look of your bathroom, adding value to your home without extending your budget.

Remember, even the most basic of bathrooms can be transformed with the addition of colourful paint, tiles and accessories.

Showers

When selecting the right shower you should consider:

- Who is going to be using the shower and what would be the best size option?
- Do you want moulded soap and shampoo holders or prefer to add your own?
- What model will best suit the theme of the bathroom or style of the house? (A three sided shower enclosure requiring only a glass door or choose two sides or three sides of glass.)
- Where is the waste positioned?
- What type of door system is most practical? (Double, bi-fold, or slide and pivot doors which come with right or left door hinges.)
- Cleaning and maintenance.

Baths and Spa baths

- If installing a shower over the bath system, ensure you choose a safe option. A bath with a wide base and an anti-slip tread for example would be a good choice. You would also want to consider the type of screen or door as a water shield.
- Baths and spa baths come in a variety of shapes and sizes. Consider water volumes, power points and, for a spa bath, the number and type of jets and where you want to locate your taps or bath spouts.

Toilets

When selecting your toilet, you will be spoiled for choice. Important things to consider are:

- P or S pan? This refers to the toilet pan. A "P" pan exits out through the wall and an "S" pan exits through the floor.
- If replacing a toilet, try and locate the new toilet close to the existing piping to save on expensive new plumbing.
- Single flush or dual flush? With the growing concern over water conservation, most new toilets come with a dual flush system that will give you the option of either half or full flushing of the water contained in the cistern.
- Bottom entry or side entry cisterns. This relates to where the water enters the cistern. If replacing a cistern, check first where the plumbing is to ensure the right choice.

Basins and Tapware

- Basins come in many shapes and sizes. They may be wall hung, semi-recessed, pedestal or inserted into vanities.
- Mitre 10 carries a large variety of top quality tapware from leading tapware manufacturers.
- Your Mitre 10 Bathroom Specialist can assist you with your choice and can also help explain the tricky things like equal and unequal pressure, ceramic disks and multi-spray shower heads.

Heating and Ventilation

- Don't forget to allow for ventilation. Mitre 10 carries a range of heating and ventilating systems to meet your requirements, including mirror demisters, heated towel rails, wall heaters, extractor fans and combination light/heater fan systems.

Accessories

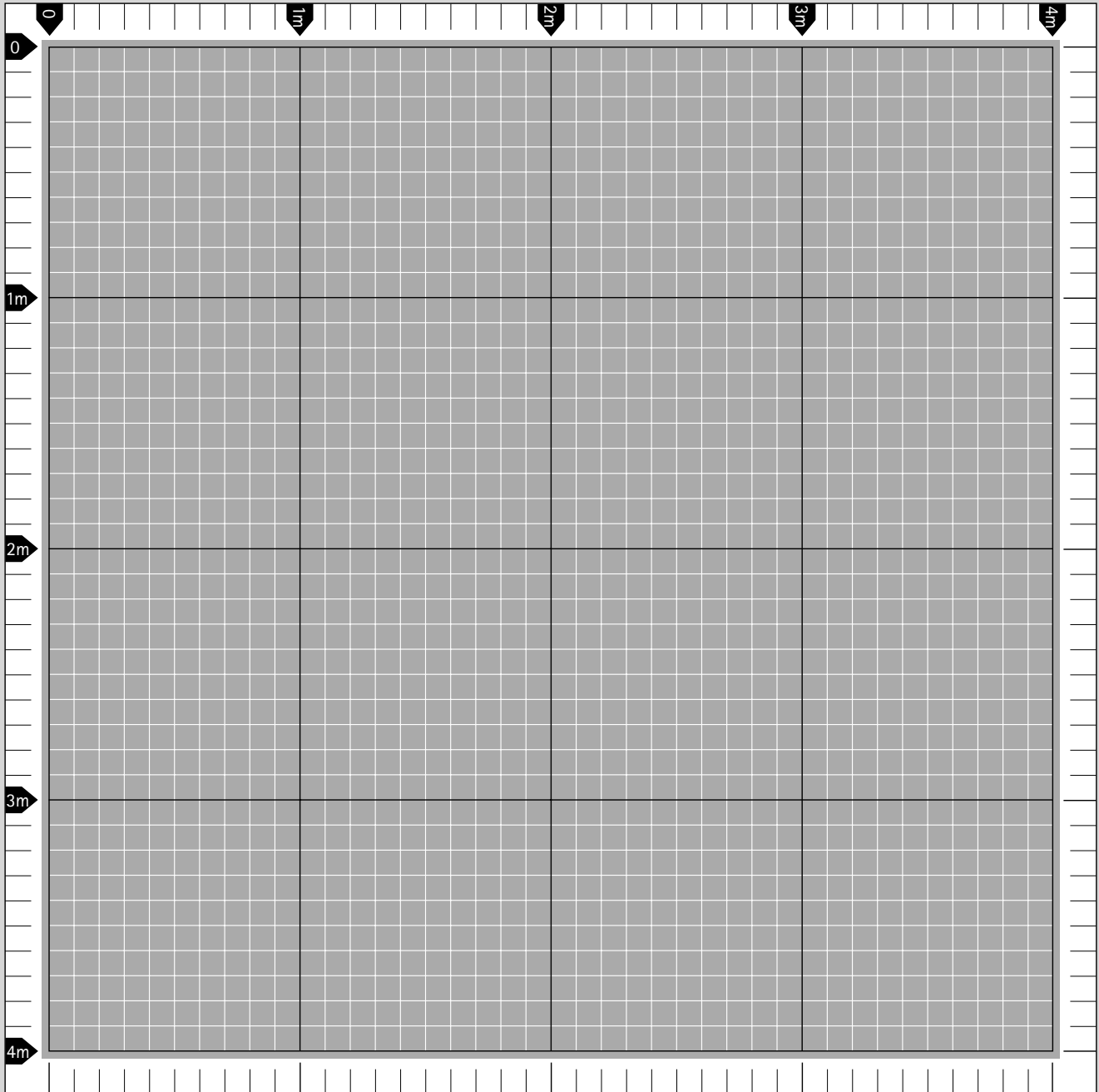

Scale 1:25 (One small square is 10cm and ten squares is 1 metre)

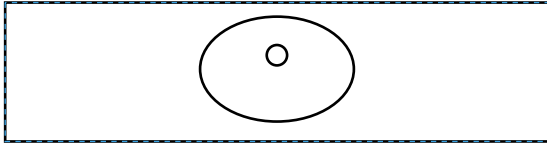

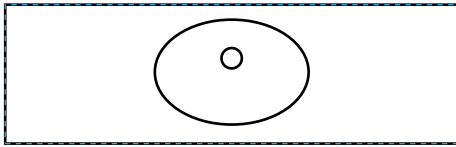

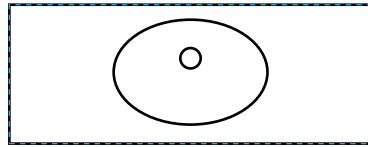
750 x 300/490 SEMI RECESSED VANITY



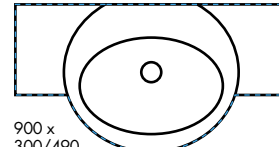

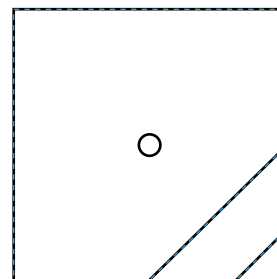
